1. Overview

1.1 Objective

The terms of delivery shall help all suppliers of Wieland Electric GmbH to overlook the requirements of all Wieland locations regarding the expected logistics performance.

The terms of delivery are aimed at guaranteeing the smooth flow of material and information between Wieland Electric GmbH and the suppliers so that the further process flow in the chain of the value added is not disturbed. The terms of delivery shall also help to achieve a continuous improvement of quality, delivery performance and cooperation with the suppliers.

1.2 Scope

The scope of the terms of deliveries refers to all products delivered to Wieland Electric GmbH by the supplier. This particularly includes the fulfillment of technical, logistic and commercial requirements and those relevant to environmental protection.

If required, product-specific demands will be stipulated in separate technical terms of delivery coordinated with the supplier and/or in the order

1.3 Process owner

Process owner is the manager of quality and processes. He is responsible for the organization and process compliance within the Wieland Electric GmbH.

1.4 Definitions

2. Supplier's responsibility

The supplier shall be responsible for the compliance with the requirements described in this document and he shall ensure that these are also kept by his subsuppliers. Thus the logistic quality of the subsupplier must be ensured by the supplier as contracting party of Wieland Electric GmbH.

The packing must protect the goods in a suitable way.

3. Restrictions and prohibitions of material

The requirements of the Wieland standard WN 5020.010 must be kept.

4.2 Permissible packing materials

- Packing materials made of plastic
- Strapping made of PVC or steel
- Fillers: Paper, air cushions, polystyrene granules, biodegradable materials
- Edge protection

4.4 Special packaging

4.5 Specific features for long materials

The length of the used wooden boxes must not exceed the transported good by more than 20 cm.

4.6 Dangerous goods

The supplier must absolutely comply with the legal provisions for the transport of "Dangerous Goods". He will also be liable for all damages resulting from this non-compliance.

4.7 Specific requirements for wooden packing

Load carriers (e.g. boxes) which do not correspond to standard packing, must have feet with a height of at least 10 cm.

5. Quantity delivered and delivery date observance

5.1 Delivery date

The confirmed delivery date is the arrival date at the defined location of the Wieland Electric GmbH!

5.2 Delivery date observance

In addition Wieland accepts deliveries which are delivered 5 working days maximum before the delivery plan. In this connection, Wieland reserves the right to return deliveries to the supplier, which are delivered more than five days before the delivery date, or to refuse their acceptance. All caused costs shall be charge to the responsible party.

Deliveries after the delivery date given by Wieland will be generally registered as delayed.

7.2 Content of delivery note

- Order number

- Gross weight
- Net weight
- Name and address of supplier
- Article number of supplier

7.3 Packing list

If a delivery contains several packages, a packing list for each package must be added to the delivery note.

7.4 Customs documents

The customs documents must be included in case of deliveries from non-EU countries. The supplier is responsible to draw up properly the documents required for the customs clearance and to hand them over

7.5 Identification of initial samples

When delivering an initial sample, the package must be noticeably identified by means of an adhesive label.
